President Biden Signs Executive Order on Labor Standards

Last Friday, President Biden signed an [executive order](#) which encourages federal agencies to prioritize federal projects, consistent with federal law, that promote Project Labor Agreements (PLAs), Community Benefits Agreements, voluntary union recognition, and neutrality with respect to union organizing. Federal agencies are encouraged to incentivize these labor standards to the greatest extent possible by including application evaluation criteria when contractors are applying for federal projects. NDA is currently reviewing the executive order to determine its impact on the demolition industry and federal contracting. More information from the White House can be [found here](#).

DOT Announces \$2 Billion in Airport Infrastructure Grants

This week, the U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT) announced \$2 billion in new airport infrastructure grants for 519 grants in 48 states and six territories under the 2021 Bipartisan Infrastructure Law. An additional \$269 million was also announced in FY 2023 Supplemental Discretionary Grants to fund 62 projects at 56 U.S. airports. This competitive grant program under the Airport Improvement Program assists airport owners and operators in the development and improvement of our nation's airport system.
